


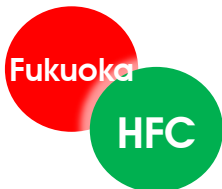
General Comments:
